Welcome to the first edition of the Range Report, our fortnightly newsletter, for this academic year.

Summer Exam Results

All our pupils have now started school and settled well, especially our new Y7s and Y12s. We were delighted with the GCSE results of the group that have become Y12, especially in a year where so much changed with the grading system and the challenge of the exams. 78% achieved at least a 4 in Maths and English and if a 4 is seen as the equivalent of a C then 76% achieved at least 5 A*-C including English and Maths, which is one of the strongest showings we have had for that statistic in recent years, and is again all the more commendable because the exams are harder. We were particularly proud of the 5 percent of entries which were awarded Grade 9, and the fact that 10 percent of our pupils achieved at least one Grade 9. National Progress statistics have not yet been released. Last year we were one of only 3 Sefton schools to achieve a positive Progress 8 score, along with Greenbank and Meols Cop, and we anticipate that our score will be positive for a second year.

At A-Level 54% achieved Grade B or above and we had our highest ever percentage of A*/A grades, with 28% of the grades awarded at A or A*. 2 students have started degrees in Medicine and 13 in some sort of Engineering. We are sure our future is safe in their hands and we are proud of them all.

Website

We have redeveloped our website and I would encourage you all to take a tour. It has a more modern feel, the pages have been reorganised, we have more photos of the pupils and there is also a mobile –friendly version for smart phones. Our Twitter feed is carried live on the home page, and we anticipate that you will find the information you need about us more easily.

We are full in all year groups and we know that part of our popularity comes from the great job our pupils do on Open Evening when they act as Tour Guides and Subject Ambassadors. I hope you will feel able to give permission for them to take part if they are interested.
