The key points we would like to stress can be found in the attached 'Remote Learning at School' information. This information was also shared with students this morning on Class Charts.

All work will continue to be set for students using Class Charts, even if this work is to be completed on a different website or digital platform. If you have not yet set up the Class Charts parent app I would ask that you do so as it will help you to monitor the work that your child(ren) has to complete and provide support to enable deadlines for completing and submitting work to be met. We are able to reissue log in credentials and assist you with setting up and navigating the parent app. Please just email admin@range.sefton.sch.uk

As work is often set in advance, the Class Charts calendar can seem overwhelming. One way to manage this effectively is to filter work using 'display by due date'. As the attached sheet explains, we understand that remote learning is not the same as being in school with a teacher and other adults to support and help, but it is important that students do as much of the work they can and ask for help and support when they need it. We are using email for this purpose.

Please tell your child(ren) not to worry if they can't complete every single piece of work set, just encourage them to try to do what they can. ***Their best is good enough!***

We know that these are far from easy times for many families and would like to thank you for your help and support.
