Dear Parents/carers

I hope you and your families are well and taking care.

We are really looking forward to welcoming back our year 10 pupils over the next few weeks. This week pupils will have had an opportunity to talk to a member of the pastoral team in relation to personal well-being. We have been listening to our pupils in terms of any concerns they have but also what they have achieved whilst being away and what they are looking forward to when they start to return to school.

From next week we will be starting a 4 week programme where pupils will have access to subject teachers. Pupils will come in for one week out of the four remaining school weeks and pupils will be in groups based upon their house. For the remaining 3 weeks pupils will be set work in the normal way via Classcharts.

Week Beginning Monday 29th June – Derby pupils (tutor groups 10EF and 10AG)

Week Beginning Monday 6th July – Sefton pupils (tutor groups 10TM and 10JT)

Week Beginning Monday 13th July – Weld pupils (tutor groups 10AK and 10RP)

We do want to ensure the week in school is as meaningful, as useful and as reassuring as possible. With that in mind, please see below the programme that we are putting in place:

*The school will finish at the end of period 3 on Friday each week for a deep clean of the school building.

Each week when pupils are in school they will follow the timetable outlined above. They will be taught in small groups by a subject specialist. Pupils should bring in their own equipment (pen, pencil and ruler and other subject specific equipment on the necessary day) and also dress sensibly but school uniform is not required. On Monday and Friday pupils will be participating in physical activity and therefore should wear trainers. On arrival, at the school gate, pupils will be met by senior and pastoral staff. Pupils will be told which group and classroom they are in with the emphasis on minimising movement around school and adhering to social distancing. Pupils should arrive into school at the normal time, between 8.40 and 8.50am. Break and lunchtimes will occur at the normal time but access to the dining room will be staggered to maintain social distancing. The school day will finish at 2.15pm Monday through to Thursday and on Friday the school will finish at the end of period 3 to allow the school building to be deep cleaned. At the end of each school day pupils will be dismissed in small groups to again ensure that social distancing is adhered to. Can I remind you that during this period the school bus service will not be running.

We are very much looking forward to this next phase of your child's learning and feel that it is really important in terms of taking a positive step towards returning to normal school life. Please do not hesitate to contact me at school if you have any further questions.
