



Range Sixth Form: 16-19 Tuition Fund Statement 2020-2021

The purpose of this statement is to set out how Range Sixth Form is planning to utilise its 16 to 19 tuition funding allocation to support students who may have had their learning disrupted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Priority intervention will be afforded to students:

- who have yet to achieve a grade 4 in English and/or Maths GCSE
- who are disadvantaged based on their socio-economic background
- with SEND status
- who are disadvantaged due to significant disruption to their learning through COVID-19
- who are disadvantaged as a result of their physical and mental health

Range Sixth Form intends to use the funding as follows:

- Provision of small group tuition in English and Maths
- Purchase of bespoke resources to support students in the targeted groups, to enable them to access learning
- Additional small group classes for targeted students including during school holidays and Saturday mornings
- Additional pastoral support to ensure the wellbeing of students to allow them to fully engage with their studies
- Additional tutorials to further enhance personal development and progression opportunities
