I am an active Parent Trustee at Range High School with a strong interest in Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND). I have 2 daughters at Range High School with a 3rd daughter due to join next year. I'm a former pupil of Range High School and work as a Consultant Cardiologist at the Liverpool Heart and Chest Hospital.

I became a Governor 4 years ago to support the school to do more to help all pupils achieve their full potential, especially those with specific learning difficulties, health or social obstacles that stand in the way of this.

The Ofsted judgment 3 years ago has been a major catalyst for improvement in the school, which has helped the delivery of positive change from 'head teacher to classroom'. I am the link governor for SEND and I'm proud of the transformation of SEND provision at Range over recent years. This includes the appointment of a full time SENDCO, improved recognition of pupils with learning difficulties and a focus on Quality First Teaching in the classroom, which differentiates teaching to support the needs of individual pupils.

My experience as a Governor / Parent Trustee and in healthcare has provided me with insight into many of the ongoing challenges that the school faces during the recovery from COVID and on the journey back to 'excellence'.
