The Languages Faculty at Range High School is a forward-thinking and high achieving department having regularly been placed in the top 20% nationally in terms of results. We pride ourselves on providing a stimulating and engaging experience for all pupils centred around educating students about the benefits of language study both linguistically and culturally.

Located in a suite of 5 teaching rooms, the Languages Faculty is currently made up of five passionate and experienced teachers who teach at least two languages. Students have access to a Language Resources room with a suite of computers and Chromebooks and green screen technology facilities.

Uptake at GCSE is approximately 50% with exciting future plans to move to "Languages For All". Groups are mixed ability in Year 7 and grouped by ability in Year 8 and Year 9. French, German and Spanish are offered at KS4 and 5 and all GCSE and A Level pupils follow the AQA Specifications.

Providing authentic, enriching experiences is something we see as integral to the language learning journey of our pupils. We have long standing links with schools in Brittany and Bavaria and we organise an annual tapas restaurant visit with our KS3 Spanish students. A-level students not only have the unique opportunity to undertake work experience visits abroad but they also run lunchtime language clubs for lower school students who share their passion for languages.
